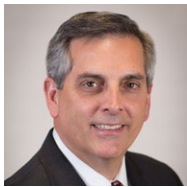
### WITH THE METRO ATLANTA ISSA CHAPTER

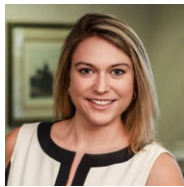
### OPENING PRESENTATION BY THE GA SECRETARY OF STATE OFFICE

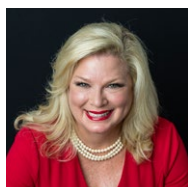




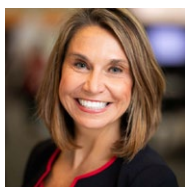
## PAYING IT FORWARD: CULTIVATING A NEW CYBERSECURITY WORKFORCE

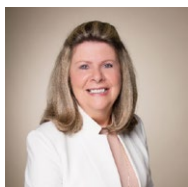
